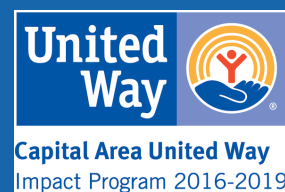

"Even if it was hard, I didn't back out because it would educate me and make me do better," said Barbara. "I invite anyone to come learn and see what I have gotten from being in the program. I am sure they will be able to get a heck of a lot out of it considering what I have accomplished."

Ashley

Ashley became a resident of Peaceful Village, a transitional housing program offered in the Acadiana area. During her stay, she was able to work hard and overcome years of substance abuse and homelessness. With support from Volunteers of America Ashley has obtained a vehicle, returned to school and has her own home. She recently graduated with a 3.658 GPA at South Louisiana Community College and is now enrolled at University of Louisiana Lafayette pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Psychology. Ashley wants to use her education to become a Counselor In Training or a Case Manager with Volunteers of America. Ashley is currently a sponsor for others battling addiction.

Erron and family

Erron's family was evicted from their apartment when his disability benefits were put on hold for recertification. This left Erron, his wife, Shanté, and their children on the streets of Baton Rouge living in their SUV. Erron noticed other homeless individuals frequenting the Drop In Center, a program designed to assist homeless individuals and families obtain treatment and housing. Erron was welcomed with open arms and met his case manager, Sharon. She helped them find affordable housing, get the kids into school and was able to find additional funds to help them with their rent while Erron and Shanté regained their financial independence. "Volunteers of America made it possible for us to find stability and relief so we could grow and find some happiness."

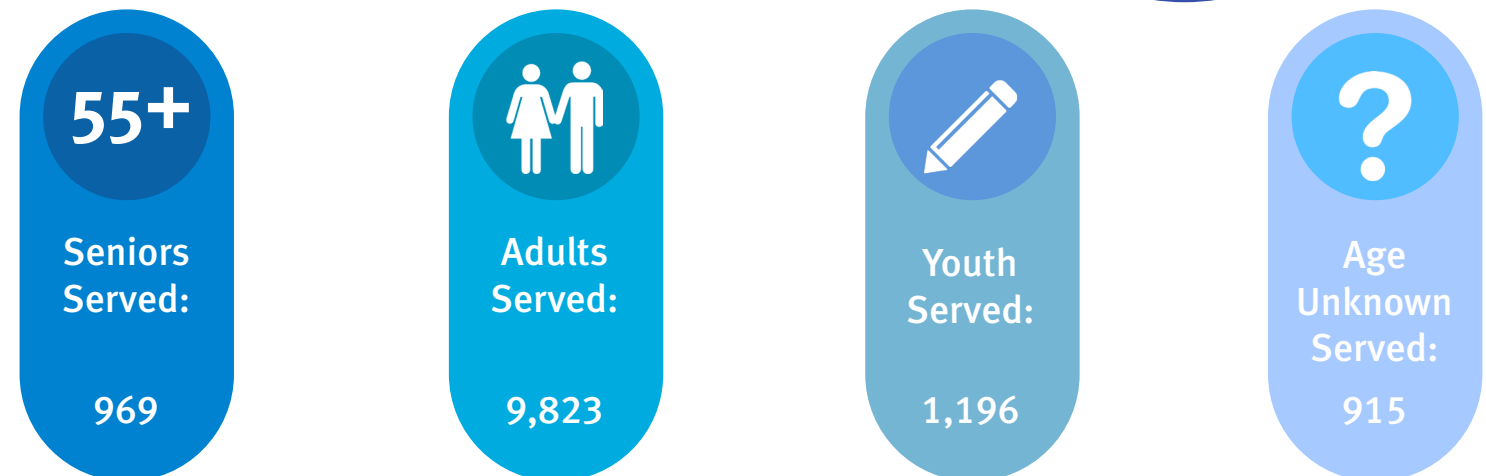
